

ETERNITY ? Life after Death ?

Infinity? limitless or endless in space, extent, or size; impossible to measure or calculate

Eternity? infinite or unending time. endless life after death

Reincarnation - the rebirth of a soul in a new body. a new version of something from the past. The ouroboros is an ancient symbol depicting a serpent or dragon eating its own tail

Resurrection? Coming alive after having been dead.

Modern Orthodox and some reform Jews believe this...

Jews – (according to an online Rabbi) After death, the body is guarded or watched from the moment of death until after burial. preventing autopsy or cremation. the focus of Judaism is on this world. Not the next. if a person abstains from a permitted physical pleasure in this world, such as enjoying a piece of fruit, the person is taken to task for this in the World to Come. Once we finish living this temporary life to the fullest, we can enjoy eternal pleasure! Initially, the soul tends to linger with the body^[12] and is certainly still focused on it during the funeral.^[13] The departed soul even listens to the Eulogies being delivered. Before the soul can be admitted to the World to Come for eternal pleasure, it must first be purified of any sins it has committed in this world.^[15] The purification process lasts a maximum of 12 months,^[16] but can be much shorter for a more pious individual. Following the purification process, the soul experiences eternal pleasure.^[20] The level and intensity of the pleasure corresponds to the good deeds and commandments that one observed while alive.

Unlike many other philosophies, Judaism maintains that the World to Come can be obtained and enjoyed by all of G-d's children, Jews and non-Jews alike.
