- 2. Submit
- 3. We choose easier, softer words like lead, follow, influence
- 4. "master" and slave?

Old hymns used these words hundreds of times –

"I love my master", more like the master, give your best to the master Over 700 times, Jesus is called Lord and or "master"

We are referred to as servants, slaves, even bondservants

To follow is to Obey – John 14:15 –

To "like" is a simple way of saying "I enjoyed" it, but not enough to comment

To follow means "I approve of you and want to see this feed" I want updates

Jesus on Facebook?

He friended me? He sent me a pm? He has a "go fund me?

He has viral memes such as "love your neighbor" but he lost a lot of followers when he lashed out at those pharisee guys.

Many are willing to "partner" – as long as we are co-equals

I would like a side of god to go please and hurry...

Many will walk in unity...until we disagree

Unity is **not** unconditional agreement simultaneously

Unity is cooperation to attain a mutual goal.

We often reserve the right to obey, follow or submit because:

we don't understand not renewed mind - worldy thinking we don't feel it (at the moment) emotionally driven
 we cling to our pride self serving narcissist

If we comply – we do it when we don't understand or agree, let alone crucify our personal ideas, choices and desires.

3 levels of "buy in"

- 1. Like and participate as long as it benefits me
- 2. Like and participate as long as its convenient / minimal investment
- 3. Committed to the cause no matter what it takes / even sacrifice everything
