The Difference in Faith and TRUST . . .

Faith – a Belief, a spiritual apprehension, assurance, conviction, doctrine

Trust – a Commitment, a long term partnership

Faith is situational

Trust is relational

Faith responds to something

Trust stays in that position

Faith is the confidence in the character of someone

Trust is **a value** that dictates priorities to stay on the path

Heb 11:1 – Faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen - 11:6 – without faith it is impossible to please Go, whoever comes to God must believe that He exists and He rewards those who seek Him.

Rom 14:1 – Accept the one whose faith is weak, without quarreling over disputable matters.

James 2:19 – You believe that there is one God. Good! Even the demons believe that—and shudder.

Faith can be limited to a head knowledge. "Just a belief"

Faith in Action is TRUST.
