Does the Church replace or fulfill Israels relationship with God?

Some say yes, but they have different ongoing roles

Israelites = Hebrew citizens living in the Nation of Israel

Jews = Faith that practices Judaism from the Torah

Zionist = those who believe and practice the Theocratic government of Gods rule in Jerusalem and the Holy Land, including the return of all Jews to their homeland.

Reformers = the central belief of Calvinism, selection, and predestination for those "Chosen" redeemed children of God.

Jews also believe and practice this separatist predestination and "chosen"
 Nationalism.

Orthodox Jew – traditional and conservative

Hasidic – modern contemporary speaking Yiddish (a Hebrew variation)

Messianic Jew – Jews who accept Jesus as Messiah

"Judeo Christian" – The combination of Old Testament Jews and New Testament Christians who hold common moral values like the 10 commandments.

Evangelical Christian – Free will inclusion by conversion of Gentiles and "whosoever will" into the family of God.

Does the Church replace or fulfill Israels relationship with God?

Some say yes, but they have different ongoing roles

For those who don't know God, haven't experienced his presence, or don't recognize the one true God...

How does HE reveal Himself?

1 Cor 2:10 - - Matt 16:17

Exod 23 – old covenant, an external position in relationship. The Holy Spirit was upon people

Joshua 21:43-45

Israel was not chosen because of who they were, how they behaved, Or because of where they are today. Only because of who HE is !

Don't worship Israel, worship the God of Israel.

New covenant – an internal spiritual personal relationship. The Holy Spirit was within people

1 Peter 2:4-10

- 1. Israel was not chosen to reveal salvation. But a representation of relationship by title and position.
- 2. The church fulfilled Israels role in the divine scheme of redemption.
- 3. Both were / are called "witnesses" of God.

There are only two groups of people that God has ever referred to as His witness; Israel & the Church. One is portrayed as the wife of God Ezek 16, Jer 3, Hosea 1,2 (she / Israel was like an unfaithful wife)

and the other as the bride of the Messiah. Eph 5, Rev 21 (a virgin waiting for the marriage)

When the church was born, did God's covenant with the nation of Israel conclude? What do Old & New Testament authors have to say about the future of Israel?

The church and The Nation of Israel play different roles in Gods plan.

PROGRESSIVE REVELATION = "Dispensation"

Continuing to the end times. 12 tribes, 12 disciples, 12 gates in heaven.

Jewish laws were Gods boundaries that brought about His blessings.

His way of living by design. Eat poison – die, defile your neighbor, you kill each other,

Did Christ do away with the law? Matt 5:17 –

"Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them.

sub groups - legal, civil, religious, ethical, dietary, customs

Jews have 7 <u>names for God</u> - El, Elohim, Adonai, YHWH, Ehyeh-Asher-Ehyeh, Shaddai, and Tzevaot.

Christians have 21 names, descriptive, titles, his character, His role, His being.

Over 50 descriptive names of Jesus. As many as 952 names and titles.

INCLUDING... I am, Emmanuel, prince of peace, mighty counselor,

Sacred Places?

The woman at the well – Samaritans worship here, Jews, over there...

Take a Holy Land tour? Favorite church in what city? "Prayer closet" in what part of the house? Is it a sacred place? Is God limited to a GPS coordinate?
